PUBLIC LAW 81-874 (Federal Impact Aid)

The Board of Trustees of the Douglas County School District recognizes that it has an obligation to ensure the participation of Native American parents in the education process. It shall be the policy of the District, therefore, to disseminate pertinent information on applications, evaluations, and program plans to parents of Native American children.

The Superintendent shall prepare a regulation that will ensure opportunities for the Washoe Tribe and parents of children residing on federal lands to:

- 1. present their views on Public Law 81-874 applications and related programs.
- 2. make recommendations concerning the needs of their children and the ways through which they may assist their children in realizing the benefits to be derived from educational programs.
- 3. consult with District personnel and become actively engaged in the planning and development of programs.

The participation of Native American children in school programs on an equal basis with all other children attending the Douglas County School District is mandated by the Board in accordance with its adopted educational philosophy, educational objectives, and District goals.
