CHAPTER I PARENTAL PARTICIPATION

In order to assure opportunity for meaningful participation in the planning and design of the Chapter I Program, the District will include parents in the annual assessment of the program. As a part of this assessment, Chapter I parents will be surveyed as to their opinions of the program. The survey instrument will seek parent suggestions for improvement in the areas of parent involvement as well as program design.

Additionally, each spring all prospective Chapter I parents will receive a description of the current program and will be encouraged to comment and offer suggestions for program improvement prior to development of the subsequent year's plan.

In order to assure opportunity for parental participation in the implementation of the Chapter I Program, parents of Chapter I students will meet early in the school year. At this meeting, they will be introduced to materials to be used in the classroom and instructed in participation with their children at home. Parents will periodically be informed about Chapter I and their children's progress in the program. They will be invited to participate in the Chapter I classroom and will be encouraged to be a part of their school's parent/faculty advisory committee. On occasion, these committees will provide input regarding program design, implementation, and evaluation of Chapter I. Parental input will be considered in any action taken to improve the Chapter I Program.
