WIDA Access for ELLs- English Language Proficiency Test

Purpose and Use of the ACCESS for ELLs Assessments

- To comply with federal regulations implementing ESSA, all school districts in New Jersey must administer the ACCESS for ELLs language proficiency assessment to all ELLs in grades K–12 or, as required, the Alternate ACCESS for ELLs in grades 1–12.
- The data supports staff, students, and families in understanding students' current level of English language proficiency.
- This data serves as one of the multiple measures to determine if students are ready to exit English Language support programs.
 - A minimum overall score of 4.5 is required to be considered for exit.
- This information supports districts in reflecting and evaluating the effectiveness of their ESL/bilingual programs.
