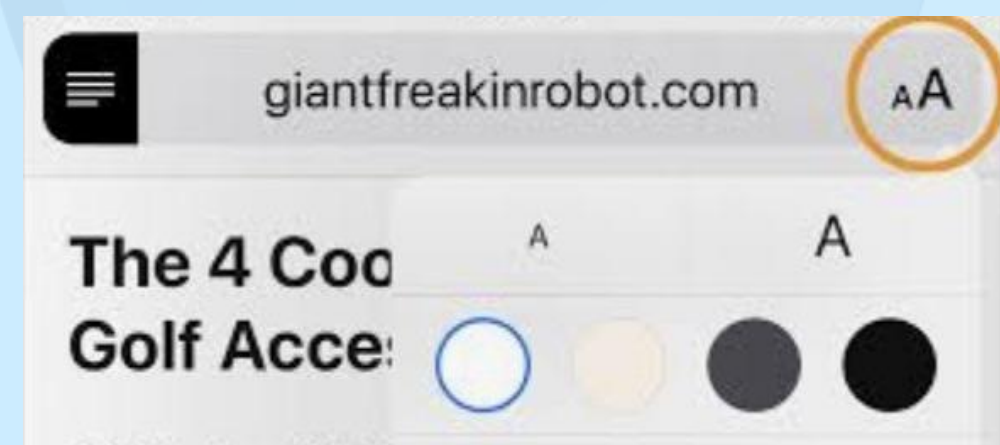
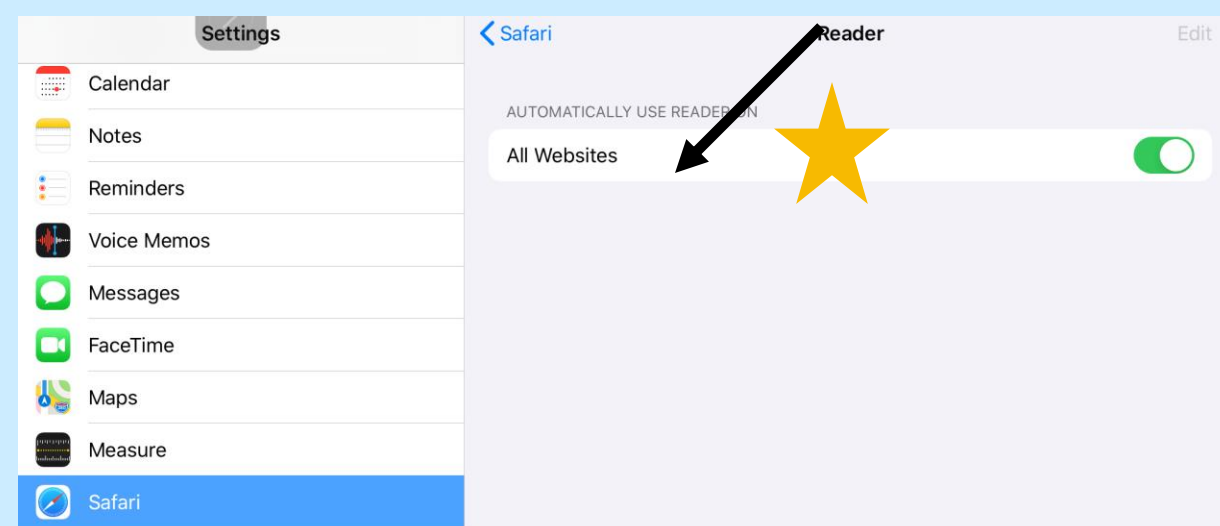
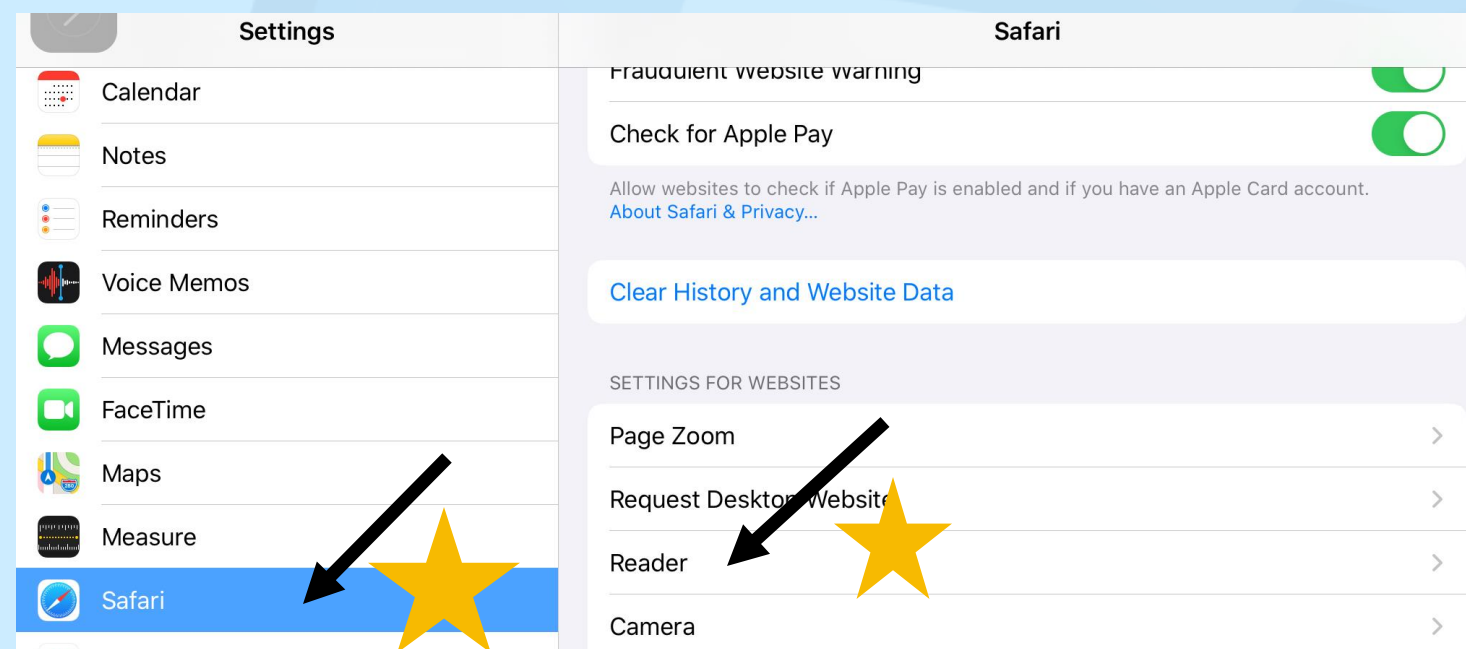
How to add Safari Reader to your iPad

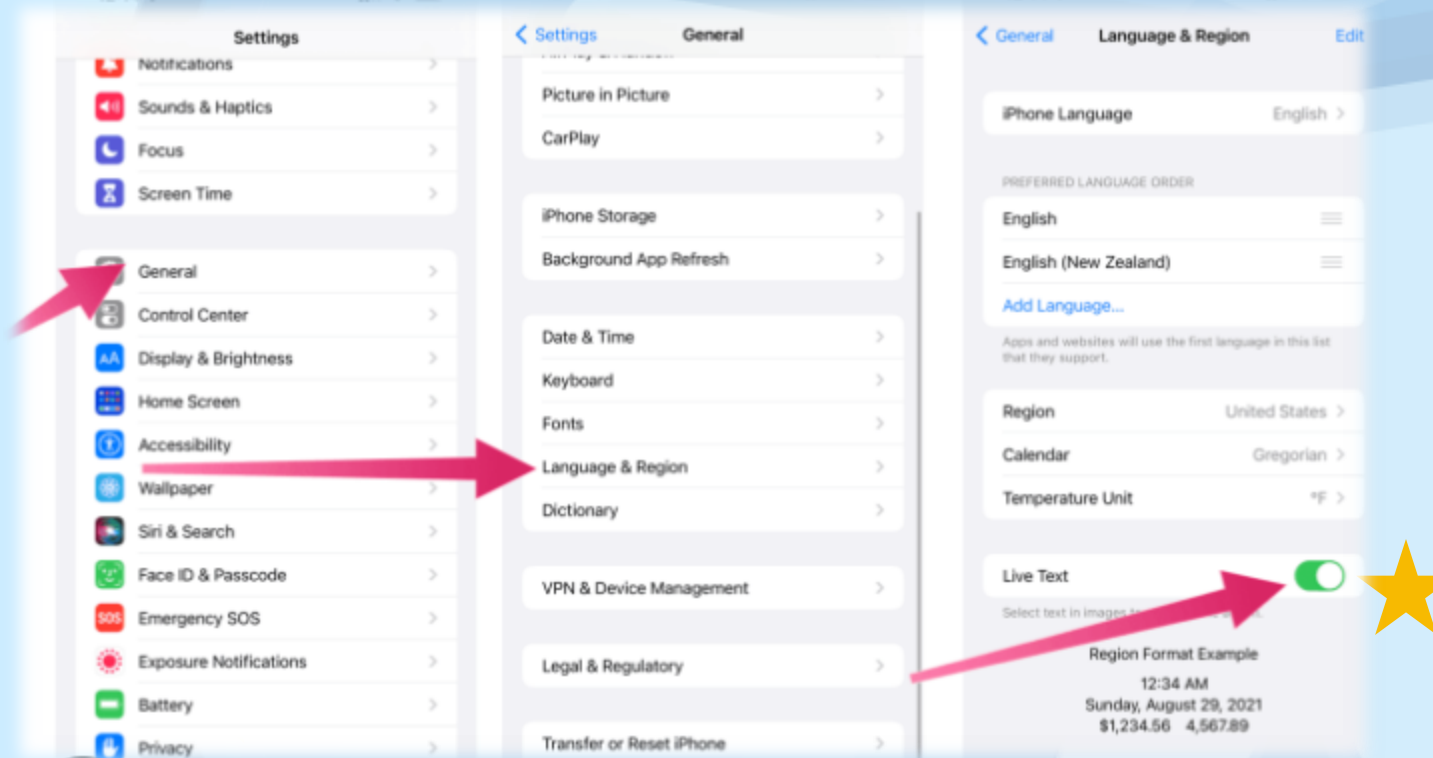
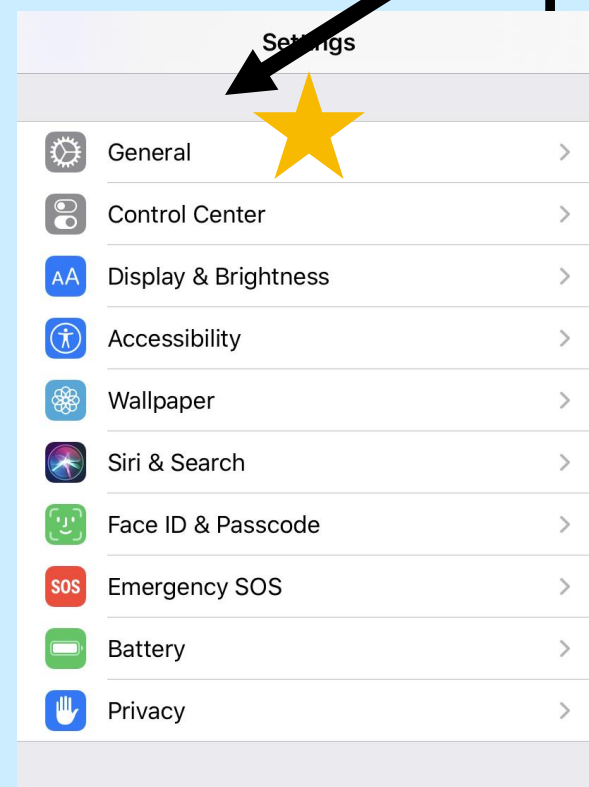

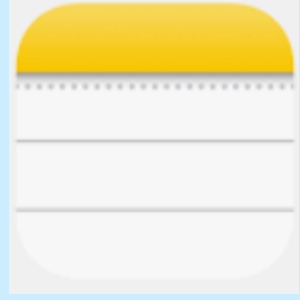

* Starting in iOS 15.4 and iPadOS 15.4, you can scan printed or handwritten text directly into the Notes app and edit it later.

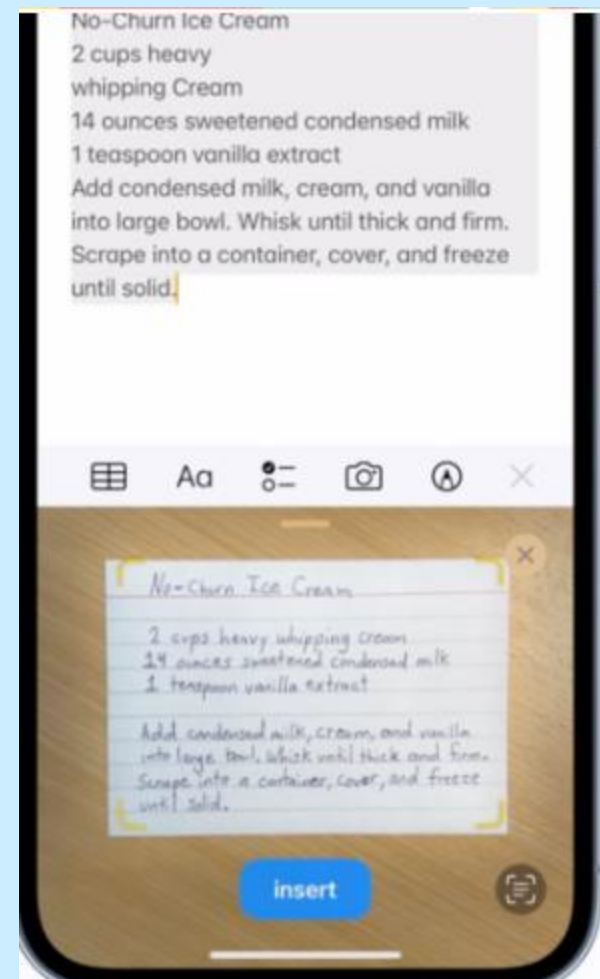
