## NAMING SCHOOLS, FACILITIES, TEAMS, AND USE OF SCHOOL MASCOTS, IMAGES or LOGOS

New district buildings will be named after a person who have attained national or local prominence in the fields of education, arts and sciences, politics, military achievements and statesmanship, after past U.S. presidents or Washington national senators or representatives, or after the geographic characteristics of the area in which the facility is located.

Districts that include "Indian Country" pursuant to 18 USC § 1151, or are in a or adjacent to a county that contains all or part of a reservation or tribal trust lands, if adjacent to a qualifying county, the tribe must be the nearest federally recognized tribe; school and team mascots, logos, or images will not be of Native American names, symbols or images unless the local tribe has approved the use by appropriate enactment or resolution.
