

STUDENT INSURANCE

The district may offer student insurance coverage. The superintendent or designee is authorized to receive quotations from insurance providers and to recommend for Board consideration the source or sources of student insurance. Upon approval by the Board, the district will distribute student insurance application forms. The District may supply the necessary claims information (time of accident, cause of accident) when requested by a student or his/her parent/guardian.

To be eligible for consideration, insurance providers must provide knowledgeable local representation to process claims, answer questions concerning coverage and procedures, and expedite communication among the claimant, doctor or medical providers and claims office. All insurance providers must be licensed to do business in the state of Washington.
