These Jefferson Elementary fourth grade students showcased their projects and shared what they learned with their parents.



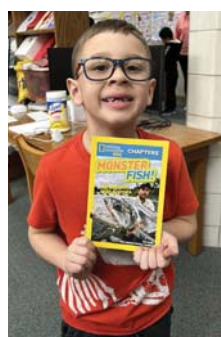
## Faribault High School Presents Winnie the Pooh
