5th Grade

ADVANCED BAKING - If you love to bake but want to have fun learning some new skills, this class is for you. We will be tasting and sharing everything we make. Yum! Students will enhance their skill development through shadow bowling, individual frame practice and various lead-up activities. Students will bowl one complete game a day. Elkhart Lake Public Library Summer Program (**SEPARATE** from Summer School Program)

The Elkhart Lake Village Library will be offering a summer program that will be held at the Elkhart Lake Village Public Library for students currently in grades 4K through 3rd grade. This program will be held on Wednesday afternoons from 12:30 pm-1:30 pm on the following Wednesdays: June 14, June 21, June 28, July 12, and July 19. *Parents will be responsible for transporting their children to and from the public library summer program unless the child is in child care.* Students who are registered for child care will be under the supervision of the child care staff who will escort students to and from the library on Wednesdays for participation in the summer library program. These same summer school-child care students will need to have with them a cold lunch on the Wednesdays when the library program is held.
