

**Background:** 

The 2023-24 Poquoson City Public Schools' Annual Plan and Report serves as the formal agreement between the PCPS School Board and the Virginia Department of Education for implementing the provisions of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004 (IDEA '04) and the Regulations Governing Special Education Programs for Children with Disabilities in Virginia (January 25, 2010). The disbursement of state and federal funds appropriated for the education of children with disabilities is contingent upon the approval of this plan and application.

#### Discussion:

PCPS maintains current policies and procedures and supporting documentation to demonstrate compliance with the Virginia Board of Education regulations governing the provision of special education and related services, licensure, and accreditation. The 2023-2024 Annual Plan is consistent with previous years and with revisions mandated by the USDOE's Office of Special Education Programs.

The Annual Plan allocates funds to:

- Meet instructional needs, provide related services, and support staffing;
- Provide purchased services including physical therapy, speech/language therapy, and assistive technology and training;
- Underwrite the costs for teachers, support staff, administrators, and paraeducators to develop skills in working with students in a variety of instructional settings;
- Acquire software and curriculum materials for those students who cannot benefit from standard curriculum material;

Poquoson City Public Schools is submitting a grant application for federal funds under the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act. The Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act provides federal funds to increase focus on the academic achievement of career and technical education students, strengthen connections between secondary and postsecondary education, and improve state and local accountability. The PCPS Perkins Funds Grant application for 2023-2024 includes funds in the following funding categories: Purchased Services and Capital Outlay/Equipment. The 2023-2024 grant application continues to support ongoing goals and objectives consistent with Carl D. Perkins Performance Measures.

The Purchased Services funds will be used for teachers to attend professional development activities at district, state and regional workshops and conferences.
