PROM

We are pleased to announce that the Junior Class of Urbana High School is hosting its annual prom on Saturday, April 29th at Urbana Country Club from 8:00 until 11:00 pm. This year's theme is A Walk Through the Enchanted Forest.

- You must be at least a third-year student with junior or senior credits to be eligible to attend prom.
- A guest application form is available in the main office. These forms are due to the main office by today. **Guest application forms will not be accepted after April 14th!** UHS students will be notified of the status of their guest application on or before April 21st.
- In order to be admitted to the prom, students and guests must purchase a ticket and register at the tables inside the country club.
- School fees must be paid in full BEFORE purchasing tickets.
- Prom tickets will be sold from April 10th - April 28th. Students may purchase tickets from Miss. Arnett during homeroom (choir room), ClimberTime (room 306), select days after school and select lunch periods (to be announced later). **Tickets are a flat fee of \$20.**
- **Tickets will not be sold at the door.**



Dress Guidelines for the evening will be as follows:

- Tuxedo, suit, or sports blazer with dress slacks including formal dress shirt and tie (vest and cummerbund are optional)
- Formal dresses or gowns may be strapless or may feature spaghetti straps. Bare or open backs are acceptable as long as they are no lower than the natural waist. Bare stomachs/midribs are permitted so long as they do not exceed two inches of exposed skin, sit too high, or sit too low. Holes or openings down the side of the torso are permitted so long as they are not lower than the natural waist or excessively high. Garments that are extremely tight, extremely short, or extremely low-cut are unacceptable. Any adjustments made to a dress or gown to meet these requirements must be a permanent fix, not temporary.

The prom will conclude promptly at 11: 00 pm. The school, class, and faculty cannot sponsor any activities after the official conclusion of the prom. After-Prom is not an official school event but rather an evening of activities planned, sponsored, and chaperoned by a committee of junior class parents.

Remind allows you the ability to control your notification preferences. You can add, remove or edit your cell phone number and email address and adjust your notification preferences at any time. Please click [HERE](#) for more information on how to control your Remind account.

Attention Medicaid Members! Don't risk losing your health coverage.

As of April 2023, Medicaid will start sending out renewal packets. You are required to complete this information to renew your current Medicaid eligibility or transition to other coverage if you are no longer eligible for Medicaid.

Make sure your address and email are up to date and current with your County Department of Jobs and Family Services (CDJFS). Renewal Packets going to the wrong address will result in the termination of Medicaid coverage. Here are ways to update your contact information:

- Call **1-844-640-6446** Monday through Friday 8 am to 4pm.
- Access your existing Ohio Benefits Self-Service Portal at benefits.ohio.gov, click on "Access my Benefits", then click "Report a Change to my Case" and follow the prompts.
- Contact your CDJFS at [Medicaid.ohio.gov/dropdown](https://medicaid.ohio.gov/dropdown), then select your county from the dropdown for contact information.

Check your mail and respond to renewal packets. If members don't respond, they risk losing their Medicaid coverage.

- Renewal packets can be completed online at benefits.ohio.gov, in-person, by mail to their CDJFS, or by phone at 1-844-640-6446.
- If the due date has passed, still send/complete online your renewal packet. You have 90 days to re-enroll without needing to submit a new application.
