
Parking Lot Gates Schedule

ORGANIZING YOUR IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

Conclusion: How long should I keep my receipts? Shred them now. Unless you're working from your home office, doing home improvements, or anything else you might get a tax credit on, you really don't need them. So, take that pile of receipts you've been collecting from your weekly grocery runs and shred them. And just in case you were wondering whether to keep warranty records, receipts for big ticket items like a TV and even proof of home repairs, you should keep them around until the

warranty **expires**, you sell that TV or move out of your house. Then shred them.

How long should I keep **property records?** That depends. You really should keep things like titles, deeds, mortgage statements and even insurance policies for as long as you own your property (or for the life of the loan). And once you say goodbye to that mortgage payment and your home is paid off, you'll be thrilled, but you'll still want to hold on to those loan documents for at least ten years.

If you've got a car, when it comes to your loan payments, contract details, titles, and proof of insurance, you'll want to hang on to those for at least ten years...just in case. Debt doesn't often come back to haunt us, but it's always a good idea to be prepared.

How long should I keep **personal** records? These are things like your birth certificate, marriage certificate, Social Security card, retirement accounts, life insurance documents, wills, and powers of attorney. You need to keep all these things forever! While your birth certificate, marriage certificate, and Social Security card matter most when you're alive, your loved ones will need easy access to your will, power of attorney, living will and life insurance policies if there's ever a time you can't speak for yourself, or after you're gone.

When it comes to wills, powers of attorney, living wills, life insurance and even information on your retirement accounts, you don't want to send your family members on a scavenger hunt to find out what they should do with your personal property.

Here's the rule of thumb: If you think you might need it, if it's a personal identification document, if it's something that has to do with finances, or if it protects your future, like life insurance or a will, then hold on to it. And remember to shred any documents with personal information on them before discarding. You never know who could get their hands on that.

That pretty much covers all you need to know about what important documents are and how long you need to keep them. This information has been adapted from an online article by Ramsey Solutions. You may already have a system in place that's working well, so no need to change. There are others, of course, that may go about organizing your important documents in a different way, but the basics remain the same about what to keep and for how long.

IRS UPDATE

The Treasury Secretary vowed to significantly improve IRS performance this year. With tax season now in full swing, it shouldn't be a difficult promise to keep, considering that the 2021 and 2022 tax filing seasons were absolute nightmares with refunds delayed for months, dismal telephone service and lengthy delays processing paper returns.

The agency has hired 5,000 customer service operators to answer the phones. Last year only 13% of callers reached a live person This very low level of service was due, in part, to a new record number of callers asking about the COVID credits, other COVID-related tax law changes, delayed refunds and suspected identity theft. So, there's hope! (Kiplinger Retirement Letter)


<u>Laudato Si'</u> is the second encyclical of Pope Francis, that he describes as "a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet."

In honor of Earth Day, consider some steps you can take toward the Laudato Si' goal of adopting a sustainable lifestyle.

- Try choosing beans and other plant-based proteins more often
- Choose fruits and vegetables that are in season and grown locally
- Try skipping the plastic produce bag, letting your food "go naked"

or using a cloth, re-usable bag

- Consider where your pantry items are from, how many chemicals were used in making them, and how they are packaged
- · Try not to waste food
- Consider eating simple meals some days, in solidarity with people with less abundance
