Community Service Seal (60 hrs)

Community service projects must address a real need or problem found within our school or community. Students must select a project that reflects both the needs of the community and their personal interests and skills. You must have your community service project/plan approved in advance by **February 1st** of every year. The following criteria should be considered when selecting a community service project:

- The project addresses a real community need or problem.
- The project provides the student with the opportunity to provide meaningful and vital community service.
- The project allows the student to gain a greater understanding of the community needs on which they are working.
- The project reflects the student's interests, talents, and abilities.
- The project provides the student with the opportunity to grow personally and/or academically.
- The project provides the opportunity for continuity of service and/or participation during the student's school experience.

The organizations and agencies listed below typically welcome volunteers. This list should help students generate ideas for community service projects.

- School Libraries Civic org. (Boy/Girl Scouts, Big Bros/Big Sis)
- Parks and Recreation Centers Political Organizations
- Nursing homes/hospices/hospitals Cultural centers/museums
- Religious Organizations
