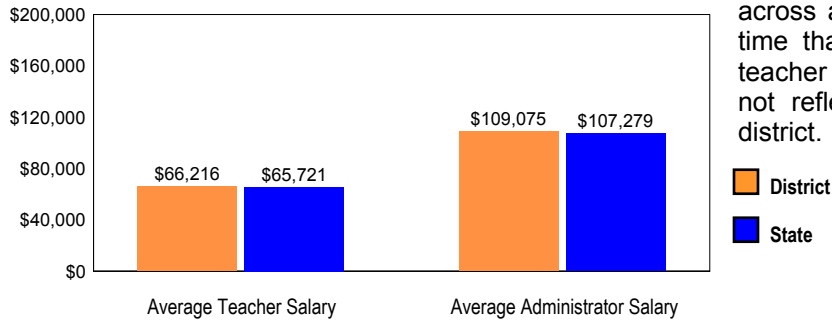

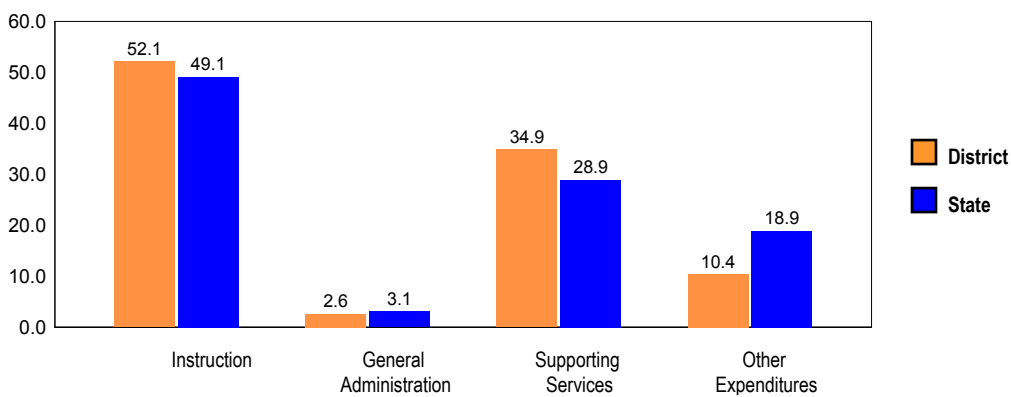
SCHOOL DISTRICT FINANCES
