Dual-Credit Programs

GCHS offers a variety of dual-credit programs for accommodating the postsecondary goals of our students. We continually review our programs to create new opportunities.

Our offerings include accelerated courses, college-prep courses, and vocational courses.

1. GCHS partners with St. Louis University through the SLU 1818 Advanced Credit Program to offer college-prep courses.

2. GCHS partners with Southwestern Illinois College (SWIC) to offer accelerated, college-prep, and vocational courses.

3. GCHS partners with Southwestern Illinois College (SWIC) to provide the Running Start and Running Start 1.0 dualenrollment program.



- GCHS has 8 students enrolled in the Running Start Program for the 2022-23 school year.





There are no tuition costs for students enrolled in SWIC dual-credit classes offered on the GCHS campus. The GCHS teaching staff will provide further information for students enrolled in SWIC courses. GPA requirements may apply to specific courses.

The Running Start Program is an off-campus dual-enrollment program which allows students to earn both their high school diploma and associate's degree while attending classes on the SWIC campus. Regular tuition and fee costs apply for students enrolled in the program.
