

Carol M. Perry, SU, has spent her life in the field of education, above all in making the Bible and its contents both user-friendly and accessible to adults. Indeed, she was the Resident Bible Scholar at Marble Collegiate Church in New York City for almost four decades, people packing her classroom at every turn! A graduate of Fordham University, Regina Mundi International School of Theology in Rome and St. Mary's College at Notre Dame, she is the author of two books, *Waiting for Our Souls to Catch Up* and *Among Women*.

Dr. Mary Coloe, pbvm teaches in the field of New Testament studies, with a particular focus on the Gospel of John. Currently, she teaches at the Australian Catholic University, and has also taught at Boston College, the Jesuit School of Theology Berkeley, and at the Ecce Homo Biblical Institute in Jerusalem. Plus, she offers in-services for teachers in schools, workshops for Parishes, and talks for Spirituality in the Pub. Among her many publications is a two-volume commentary on *John* which was published as part of the Wisdom Commentary series. She has also written: *Dwelling in the Household of God: Johannine Ecclesiology and Spiritualty; A Friendly Guide to the Birth of Jesus; A Friendly Guide to John's Gospel*; and the "Introduction to Johannine Literature" for the *New St Jerome Biblical Commentary*. Dr Robert A. Willis, KStJ DL is an Anglican priest, theologian, chaplain, lecturer, and hymn writer. He was Dean of Canterbury from 2001 to 2022, having previously served as Dean of Hereford between 1992 and 2000. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Church of England suspended public worship. In response, Willis, began to broadcast religious services from every part of the deanery garden at Canterbury Cathedral, from its pigsty to its roof! His video recordings of the daily service of Morning Prayer were watched by thousands of people around the world who dubbed themselves the "Garden Congregation". By the time he retired in May 2022, he had



produced well over 900 broadcasts and had accrued millions of followers on YouTube, reaching many who needed a point of contact, spiritual or otherwise, in the dark days of the lockdown. His daily broadcasts filmed in every conceivable weather were built around Scripture, interweaving all aspects of human history and creativity in arts, music, philosophy, and literature into each service. He was awarded an honorary Doctor of Divinity (DD) degree by the Berkeley Divinity School at Yale University in 2009, an honorary Doctor of Civil Law (DCL) degree by the University of Kent in 2011, and the title of Dean Emeritus of Canterbury by the Archbishop of Canterbury in 2023.



Dr. Ronald D. Witherup, PSS is the former Superior General of the society of the Priests of St. Sulpice and academic dean and professor of Sacred Scripture at St. Patrick's Seminary and University, Menlo Park, CA. He is currently teaching Scripture at the Biblicum in Rome and is awaiting the news of his next great adventure. An authority on Paul, Witherup has written many books covering multiple areas of the Bible. His works include *Saint Paul and the New Evangelization* (Liturgical Press), *Mercy and the Bible: Why it Matters* (Paulist Press), and *Conversion in the New Testament* (Zacchaeus Studies). He is also a presenter of two programs in Now You Know Media: *St Paul: His Life, Faith and Legacy* and *St Paul's Letters: First and Second Corinthians and Galatians.*
