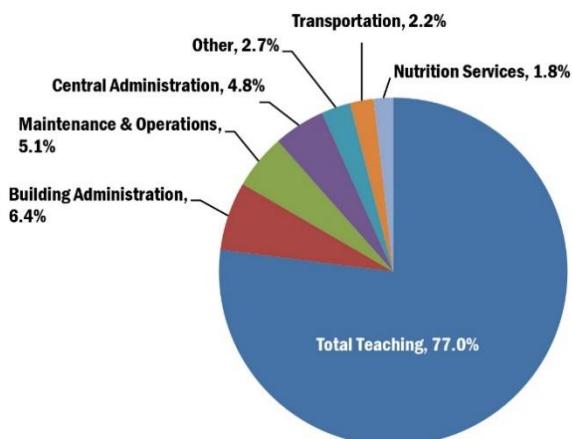
## 2021-22 School Goals

Staff members analyzed data and identified areas of focus to increase student performance. Action steps with specific instructional strategies were articulated for each goal.

- **Grades K-5 English Language Arts:** 85% at standard
- **Grades K-5 Math:** 78% at standard
- **Grades K-5 Social Emotional:** 60% of students will indicate they are able to pull themselves out of a bad mood & demonstrate resilience through Panorama Survey Data
- **Opportunity/Achievement Gap:** 66% of students identifying as Latino will meet or exceed standard

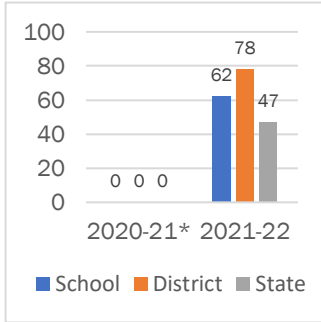

*Where does the money go?*

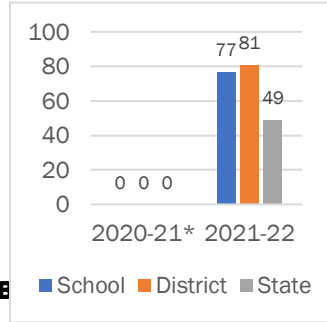

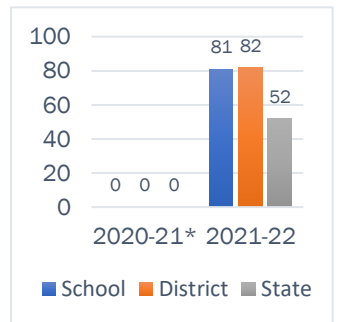
**3rd Grade English Language Arts**



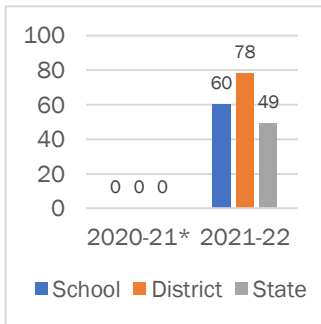
**4th Grade English Language Arts**



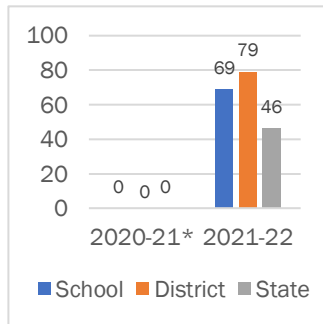
**5th Grade English Language Arts**



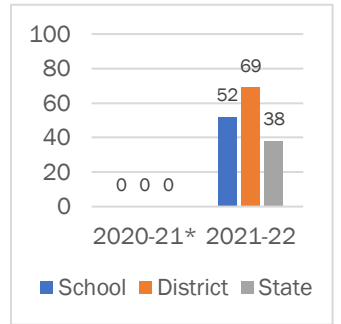
**3rd Grade Math**



**4th Grade Math**

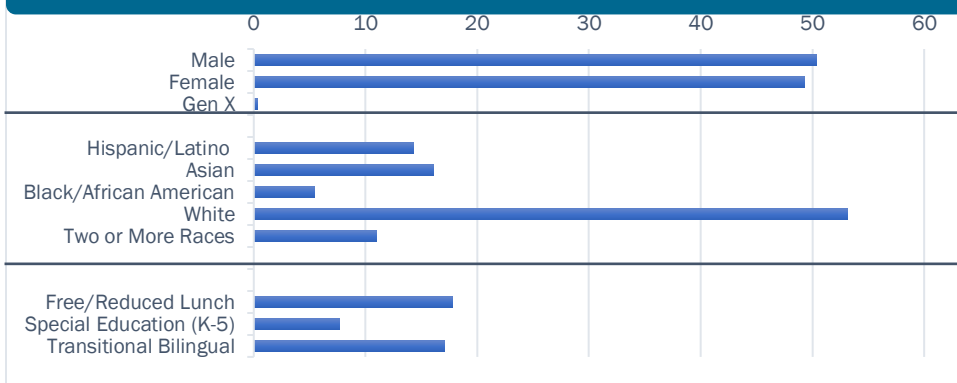
