Bio: Jim Curtin is an American professional soccer coach and former player who is the current head coach of the Philadelphia Union of Major League Soccer. He spent most of his playing career with the Chicago Fire. Curtin grew up in Oreland, PA, and played high school soccer at Bishop McDevitt and college soccer at Villanova University. He has been the head coach of the Philadelphia Union since 2014. Jim is the parent to Ryan, Class of 2025.

Bio: Fiechter grew up playing junior squash at the Philadelphia Cricket Club, Springside Chestnut Hill Academy, and at Germantown Friends. She represented Team USA four times at the World Junior Championships from 2011-2014. In her senior year of high school, she received the DeRoy Sportsmanship Award for her exceptional demeanor on and off court. Fiechter attended Princeton University where she was a four-time All-American and All-Ivy league player, co-captain, and a Richey Award finalist. She turned professional after graduating in 2018 and is currently ranked 7th in the world.

Sam Fuld – Parent '28, P'30, P'32, P'34

Former Pro Baseball Player, current General Manager of the Philadelphia Phillies

Bio: Sam Fuld was named vice president and general manager of the Phillies in December 2020, which is his third position with the club. He had originally been hired by Philadelphia in November 2017 as the major league player information coordinator, a position he held for two years before being promoted to director, integrative baseball performance in January 2020. Fuld is the fifth former major league player to hold the position of general manager with the Phillies. Fuld worked closely with the Major League coaching staff as an outfield instructor and helped integrate advanced metrics. A former Major League outfielder, Fuld played parts of eight seasons for the Chicago Cubs, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland As, and Minnesota Twins and starred at Stanford University.

Fuld is the parent to Charlie, Class of 2028; Jane, Class of 2030; William, Class of 2032; and Spencer, Class of 2034.

Bio: A 2000 graduate of the University of Maryland, Kahoe was a part of the teams that won five national championships and three ACC championships. A three-time All-American and ACC Goalie of the Year, and two-time NCAA Goalie of the Year, she also earned ACC Rookie of the Year honors in 1997. Kahoe was inducted into the University of Maryland Athletics Hall of Fame on October 3, 2014. Alex Kahoe is currently in her ninth season as the head coach of the Saint Joseph's women's lacrosse program.

Kahoe became the first coach in program history to lead SJU to back-to-back postseason appearances, in 2016 and 2017, and has since led the Hawks to six postseasons in a row, including the A-10 title and the programs first NCAA berth in 2022.

Bio: Garrett Miller began his rowing career at Lasalle College High School and continued rowing at the University of Pennsylvania. He was the captain of the University of Pennsylvania Rowing Team (1998 – 1999) and led them to the Ivy League and Eastern Sprints Championship in 1998. He was recently inducted into the United States Rowing Hall of Fame as a member of the 2014 class. He was a member of the U.S. Olympic Team competing in the 2000 Sydney Olympic Games where he placed 5th as a member of the Men's Open 8+, and is a three-time world rowing champion.

Bio: Blaze Riorden is a Fairport, NY, native where he attended Fairport High School. While playing lacrosse at the University of Albany, he was named an All-American and was the America East Defensive Player of the Year. Riorden plays for the Chaos Lacrosse Club of the Premier Lacrosse League and as a forward for the Philadelphia Wings of the National Lacrosse League. In the PLL he has won three straight Oren Lyons Goalie of the Year awards, making him the first goalie to do so. He is also one of only two field lacrosse goalies to win league MVP at the professional level and is widely regarded as one of the greatest lacrosse goalies of all time.

Riorden is a current assistant coach for the SCH boys lacrosse team.

Bio: Don Spragan attended James Logan High School in Union City, CA, where he lettered in football, basketball, and baseball. As a football player, he won All-League honors at both quarterback and linebacker. Spragan attended Stanford University. Upon graduation in 1999, he was drafted by the New Orleans Saints. His ten year professional career included nine years in the NFL, playing for the New Orleans Saints, Green Bay Packers, Cleveland Browns, Denver Broncos, Miami Dolphins, Buffalo Bills, and the Amsterdam Admirals (NFL Europe).

Basketball - college basketball star and basketball coach

Bio: JD Walsh was a High School McDonald's All-American (Honorable Mention) in basketball his senior year at St. Thomas More School and was a full scholarship team member of the University of Maryland's men's basketball team from 1991 to 1993. He competed in the Empire State Games in 1991 and in 1996 followed by a semi-professional stint in Ireland for St. Vincent's Dublin.

Walsh began as a volunteer coach in 1997 for Vincent Smith, assisting the Aim High AAU Team in Queens, NY. He began his high school coaching career in 1998 at Roslyn High School and on to St. John the Baptist Diocesan High School from 1999 to 2004. He has worked as a basketball trainer for hundreds of players including former and current NBA and WNBA players Shay Doron, Troy Murphy, and Smush Parker. He has also worked with the New York City Department of Education through its CHAMPS program and written a handbook for all New York City Public Schools Junior High School basketball coaches. Walsh has trained with the Chinese Basketball Association, Dominican Republic National Team, Beijing Ducks, United States Department of State, Maccabi Tel Aviv, and Israel Junior Team.

While developing other businesses, JD started the JDBASKETBALL School, in 1998 in Great Neck, NY, to teach local kids in the New York metro area the fundamentals of basketball. Since then, it has evolved into global enterprise that has operated on three continents with more than 15,000 participants involved. Walsh has toured countries and held camps worldwide in countries such as China, Dominican Republic, India, Italy, Kashmir, Qatar, and Taiwan.
