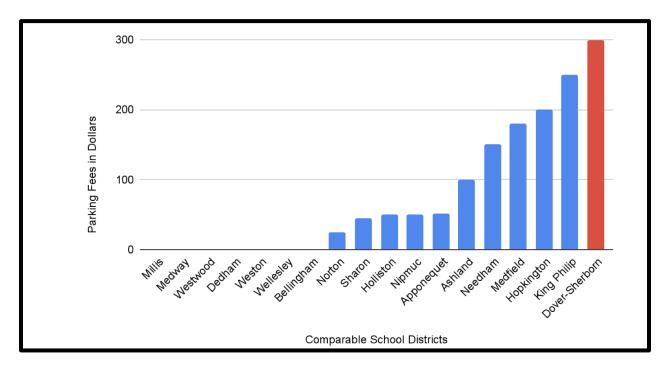

As promised at our 2.7.23 meeting, I have done some research on local districts and their parking and/or bus and athletic fees. I tried to also gather activity fees but they were so all over the board and hard to summarize that they were not really consistent or comparable. I hope this is helpful in our deliberations.
