INCLEMENT WEATHER

This is to inform you of an important procedure regarding delayed openings, early dismissal and school closures due to inclement weather.

If your school district has a delayed opening, students will be excused from The Academy for the AM session. Your child's attendance will be excused for the day. However, students enrolled in our afternoon session should report at their normal time.

If your school district is closed but our classes remain open, you have the option of sending your student to our Center. You will be required to provide for your child's transportation needs to and from our Center. If you choose not to send your student, your child's absence will be excused for the day. Please note that due to the New York State mandate on classroom hours, students attending the Practical Nursing program should make every effort to attend class.

In the event of an early closure, your child will remain in our building until transportation can be arranged. In most instances, this transportation will return your child to their home high school.
