

#### 2021-22 School Goals


- Grades 6-8 English Language Arts (ELA): 89% of all students will meet or exceed standard on the 2019 ELA SBA

- Discipline: We will decrease our percentage of chronically absent students from 10.78% to 5%.






6th Grade English Language Arts




7th Grade English Language Arts




8th Grade English Language Arts






