



Determining Eligibility under the McKinney-Vento Act

Students eligible under the McKinney-Vento Act are entitled to immediate enrollment. In such cases, proof of residency and other documents normally needed upon enrollment can be obtained following enrollment. (If there is a problem after enrollment in obtaining any records, please contact Project Rise at 330-761-2969). Students protected under McKinney-Vento may also be entitled to transportation as well as to other services meant to assist in maintaining educational and housing stability. Please assist students and families in completing the information below. This form is intended to address the McKinney-Vento Act which provides additional services to students if their RESIDENCE IS NOT FIXED, REGULAR AND ADEQUATE.
