Chadwick International opened in 2010 as the second campus of Chadwick School in Palos Verdes, CA established in 1935. Chadwick International is a PreK-12 non-profit, coeducational international school in Incheon, South Korea. Chadwick International is also an accredited International Baccalaureate school for the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), Diploma Programme (DP), and Career-Related Programme (CP), as well as the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). The Class of 2016 was the first cohort to graduate from Chadwick International School.

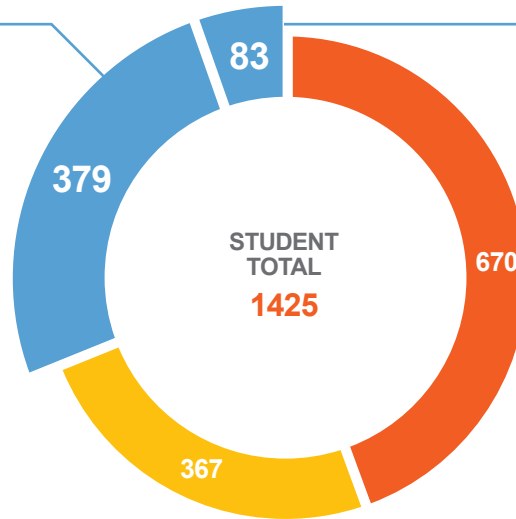

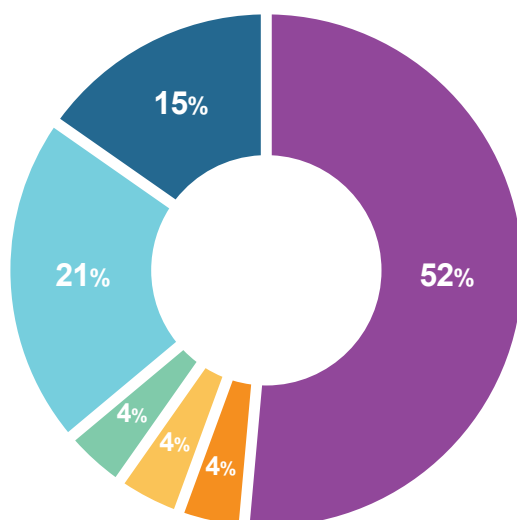
Financial Aid

Of the 53 teaching faculty members, 83% hold teaching certificates/advanced degrees. On average our faculty have 3+ years of service at Chadwick International.

Outdoor Education

Chadwick Schools' unique Outdoor Education program encourages students to live our mission through small group extended journeys in challenging and adventurous expeditions in the wilderness. The Chadwick International course of study includes Outdoor Education for all students in grades 4-12, focusing on a specific curriculum which includes developing a sense of self, conflict resolution skills, leadership skills, resilience, understanding community, appreciating the natural world, and developing outdoor skills.

Community Service

Chadwick International encourages students to get involved with their communities through volunteer activities; combines community service with pre-planned, thoughtful reflection activities; and extends student learning beyond the classroom into the community. It is an educational experience in which students work with others, apply what they are learning in class to community problems, and reflect upon their experiences as they seek to gain a deeper understanding of skills and concepts in the community. The program seeks to foster a lifelong, active commitment to service in our students. Students across all grade levels are encouraged to participate and opportunities exist for weekly involvement within the local community as well as for participation in international service trips.

Round Square Program

In October 2014, Chadwick School was elected to membership in Round Square, thereby joining more than 100 other schools from 18 countries on five continents. In 2017, we became a Round Square Global Member. Round Square schools all share a commitment to the "six pillars" of Round Square: Internationalism, Democracy, Environment, Adventure, Leadership and Service, commonly referred to as the IDEALS. Our membership in Round Square supports our commitment to developing global citizens. Through this organization, students can participate in exchanges and engage in international conference and service projects with students from other member schools from around the world.

Chadwick International COVID Statement

From February 2020 through SY 2021-2022, CI students had limited access to school-based co-curricular activities; many student-led activities had to be canceled or postponed. Despite this, students were able to develop independent and individual ways to continue their involvement in sports, service, and the creative arts. During online learning, CI adopted an assessment policy that allowed students to earn a P (Pass) for demonstrated learning in a given course. Due to the global effects of the pandemic, standardized testing options for International students were severely curtailed. Even where testing was available, sudden test cancellations, center closures, and poorly-functioning registration systems adversely affected students' abilities to follow their planned or ideal testing schedules.

Curriculum

Chadwick International is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP) and the Career-Related Programme (IBCP).

Year 11 and 12 students can choose to take the full IB Diploma Programme, some IB courses to complete the CI Diploma, or the IBCP. Chadwick International requires that students in the full IB DP take no more than three HL courses.

Students are NOT ranked at Chadwick International and we do not provide GPAs.

Students receive one full final report (June) and one mid-year progress report (January).

Students are required to study MYP subjects from Year 9 – 10, and complete a Personal Project (Year 10 only).

Expected/Predicted IB Grades will only be provided upon direct request from universities.

• Academic Policy and Diploma Requirements

All Chadwick International graduates receive an American High School Diploma.

A minimum of 22 credits are required for graduation (20 for students with approved accommodations).

Special Notes for the Chadwick Math / Science Curricula

* The Math curriculum is similar in integrating Algebra I & II, Geometry, and Trigonometry. The Standard Math Pathway is based on the Standard Common Core curriculum. The Extended Pathway is based on the Accelerated Common Core curriculum.

** In Grades 9 - 10, the MYP curriculum integrates Biology, Chemistry, and Physics which is deepened and enriched over the two years. The sequence is required and each year's course is a laboratory science course.
