





# Elementary Literacy Data by School % of students who are proficient or above




## U-32 Literacy Data by Grade % of students who are proficient or above




# SIXTH GRADE LITERACY SBAC 18-19 PERFORMANCE DISAGGREGATED BY POVERTY & IEP



# Elementary Math Data by School % of students who are proficient or above




# U-32 Math Data by Grade % of students who are proficient or above




# SIXTH GRADE MATH SBAC 18-19 PERFORMANCE DISAGGREGATED BY POVERTY & IEP








## Report Card Proficiency by Content SLO By School % of students who are proficient or above




