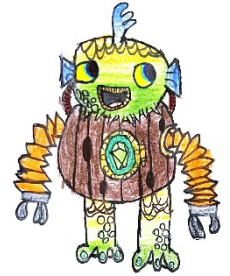
## Bellowfish – a Poem

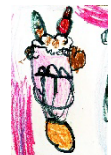

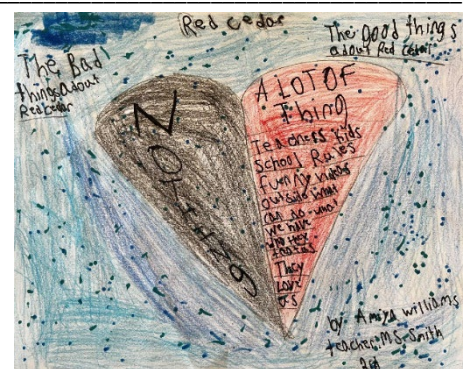
