Todd Baker is a 20-year resident of Dix Hills, NY. During that time, he and his wife, Dr. Heidi Levine-Baker, raised three children who received their K-12 education through the Half Hollow Hills Central School District.

One of Mr. Baker's first jobs out of college was as a substitute middle and high school teacher for the Los Angeles Unified School District. He was also an adjunct professor at New York University, School of Continuing and Professional Studies. Mr. Baker strives to integrate that experience as an educator into his volunteer activities with the fire department and his profession as a television and film producer.

The past 26 years of that career include such notable productions as the educational animated series "The Wonder Pets" on Nick Jr., "Escaping Alaska" on TLC, "Grammy: Red Carpet Live" on CBS, "The Global Citizen Festival," "The Big Idea with Donny Deutsch," "The Nick Cannon Show" on Nickelodeon, and many others. In addition, he formed an all-female auto race team for his MTV pilot "Built for Speed."

Since 2008, Mr. Baker has been an active volunteer firefighter with the Dix Hills Fire Department. He recently added fire police duties to his firematic activities. In 2017, he and Fire Commissioner Todd Cohen co-created Long Island's first Junior Firefighter summer camp for children ages 10-14. In association with the Dix Hills Fire Department and the Town of Huntington Parks and Recreation Department, they designed the endeavor to teach children about our local emergency services and instill a sense of community service.

Mr. Baker holds a master's degree in journalism from Columbia University. He is also a Producers Guild of America member and formerly part of its east coast steering committee and the chapter's Co-Chair of Recruitment and Membership.

The decision to run for a seat on the Board of Education for the Half Hollow Hills Central School District resulted from a desire to give back. Those efforts began in 2017 when Mr. Baker and his wife proposed an educational concept to Superintendent Dr. Patrick Harrigan. That discussion prompted the administration's exploration, development, and creation of a related plan that ultimately resulted in the Hills Academy.



IMPORTANT VOTER INFORMATION

VOTER REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible to vote you must be:

- a citizen of the United States, and
- a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and
- at least 18 years of age, and
- a registered voter.*

* Anyone who voted in a school or general election during the four years prior to the pending election need not re-register.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Where: District Clerk's office at the Fran Greenspan Administration Center 525 Half Hollow Road, Dix Hills 11746

When: Any school day, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Registration is required if you have not voted within four years in a general election or school election. For more information, please contact the District Clerk at (631) 592-3013 or check the Board of Elections website (https://suffolkcountyny.gov/Departments/BOE) to see if you are registered.

The LAST day that a resident may register at the Fran Greenspan Administration Center to vote in the May 16, 2023 Budget Vote and Trustee Election is Thursday, May 11, 2023 before 4:00 p.m.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Applications for absentee ballots for election of school board members and for voting on the school budget are to be completed on a form prescribed by the state board of elections and may be obtained by visiting https://www.hhh.k12.ny.us/district/budget-information, or by contacting the District Clerk by telephone at 631-592-3013 or by email at fspeciale@hhh. k12.ny.us. Completed applications must be received at least seven days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the applicant, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the applicant or to his or her designated agent.
