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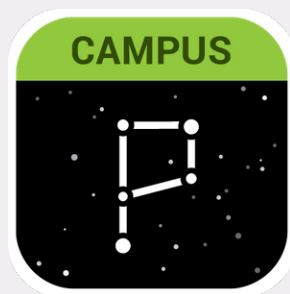
WEEKLY PARENT COMMUNICATION

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We recommend all students transitioning into 6th grade attend **summer school** and the **6th Grade Orientation Day** August 10, 2023.

Our W.E.B. program focuses on creating a positive experience for ALL students. This program creates a structure of support for 6th grade students to receive mentorship from our 8th grade WEB leaders. We launch this structure of support on our 6th Grade Orientation Day that takes place in August.

When 6th graders attend summer school, they will be enrolled in a 6th grade Jump Start course. This course was developed to support the social, emotional, and environmental needs of students as they transition from elementary to middle school. The goal is to ease fears and concerns commonly experienced by adolescents transitioning to middle school while also offering education about some common topics. It is our goal to smooth the transitional experience. During summer school, collaboration, teamwork, mentorship, and friendship-building will be key components woven throughout the units to help students feel safe, connected, and supported as they enter middle school.
