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## Overview of Accountability Ratings

Domain	Overview	Scoring Weight
<b>Domain I: Student Achievement</b>	Combined average of "Approaches" + "Meets" + "Masters" for all students, all subjects, all tests. High schools and districts also have CCMR and graduation rates calculated into this domain.	Best Score in Domain I or II = <b>70% of Rating</b>
<b>Domain IIA: Academic Growth</b>	Percentage of students meeting their individual "growth target" score in reading and math based on the prior year score.	
<b>Domain IIB: Relative Performance</b>	Domain I score compared to other schools/districts with the same percentage of economically disadvantaged students.	
<b>Domain III: Closing the Gaps</b>	Matrix calculation based on the number of passing and growth rate targets made for individual student groups (i.e., ethnicity, economically disadvantaged, EB, SPED)	<b>30% of Rating</b>

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## Overview of Accountability Ratings

### Last Four Years of State Testing and Accountability

- **2018-19:** Last year with STAAR testing and school accountability ratings
- **2019-20:** Cancellation of STAAR testing and suspension of accountability ratings due to COVID-19 pandemic
- **2020-21:** STAAR testing returned, but continued suspension of accountability ratings
- **2021-22:** STAAR testing and accountability ratings are reinstated. However, SB 1365 established that schools and districts earning a D or F for the 2021-22 school year would be given a label of "Not Rated".

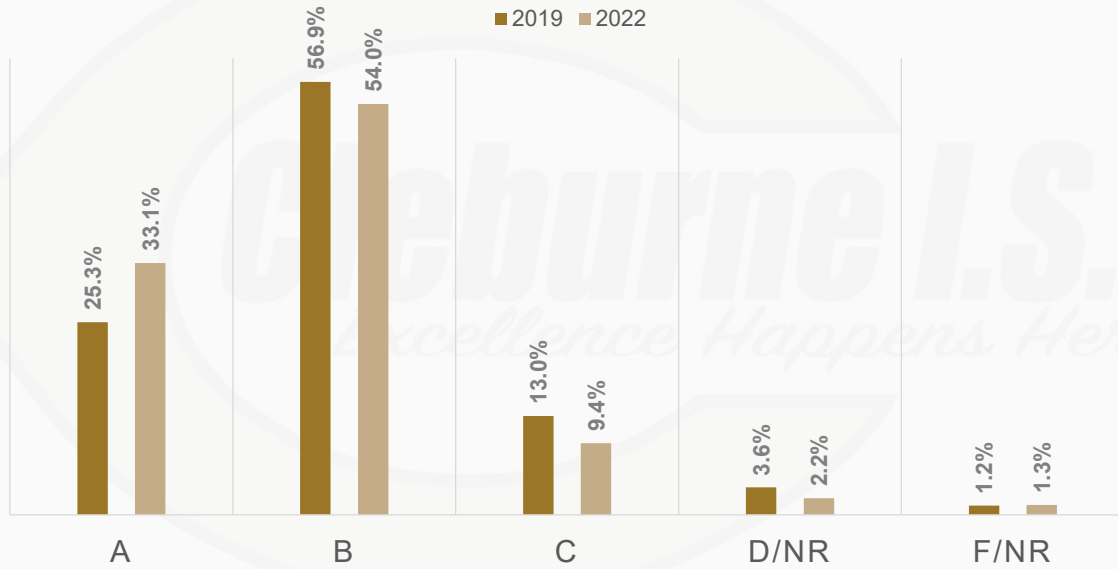

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## What Attributed to Higher Accountability Ratings in Cleburne ISD?

- Focused efforts in improving systems, specifically our data/planning meeting PLC process as part of our Relay GSE “Leverage Leadership” training with principals.
- Setting individual growth goals and targets for each student, tracking process toward that goal, and engaging in intervention when needed.
- Tracking of every high school student in their progress toward meeting CCMR criteria in at least one area.
- High quality teachers and solid Tier 1 instruction combined with a low turnover rate.
