CISD students will engage in the following assessments, designed to measure college readiness & career aptitude.

PSAT Suite of Assessments

- 8th & 9th graders take the PSAT 8/9 free of cost.
- 10th & 11th graders take the PSAT/NMSQT free of cost.
- The PSAT suite of assessments, created by College Board, measures reading, writing & mathematical skills
- Scoring well on the PSAT/NMSQT could qualify a student for National Merit status- a prestigious honor that means big money for college!

SAT School Day

- Offered to 12th grade via sign-up in counseling office
- Limit 50 students (first come, first served)
- \$64.50 ; \$15.00 for Free/Reduced lunch students
- Full-length SAT with Essay

ASVAB

- Offered free of cost to all 12th grade students
- A vocational aptitude test
- Measuring skills like:
 - Science & math knowledge
 - Spatial reasoning
 - Mechanical comprehension & more
