## Mandated Immunization Requirement For School Attendance

Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardians:

State law requires all new admissions to be up to date on their immunizations. There have been some changes in what is required. Please see chart below.

- **Where can my child get this vaccine?**
  - Your medical provider
- **What else do I need to do?**
  - **Your child will not be registered without updated immunization documentation.**
- **What if my child is unable to take this vaccine for medical reasons?**
  - Medical Exemptions to the law may be granted in accordance with State Health Department requirements through the CAIR-ME process. For questions regarding CAIR-ME, please contact your health provider or school nurse. Under California State law, personal beliefs exemptions are no longer accepted for school entry.
