Measure G has helped fund over \$55 million in facility needs at six elementary schools to date. Projects completed at these schools focus on health and safety, major maintenance, and modernization including new construction, asphalt replacement, fire alarm and suppression upgrades, structural repairs, plumbing and flooring improvements, and more!

***All schools received new or upgraded video surveillance, fire alarm, and paging systems, in addition to the projects listed below!**

Projects Not Funded Through Measure G

Several of our schools have not been closely aligned with Measure G due to *limited funds*. We are planning on addressing as many of these schools' needs as we can, but projects identified in the 2019 Facility Needs Assessment remain **unfunded**, totaling **\$427 million**.
