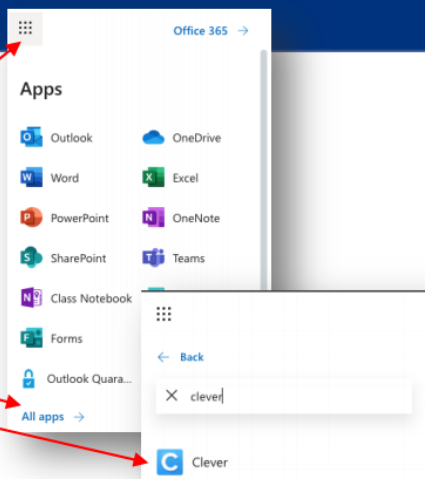




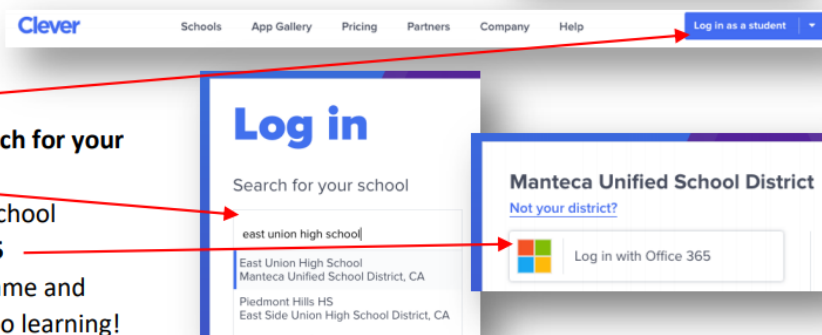
1. Many of our learning tools are accessed through Clever.com

- This tool takes care of **student login**
- Gives access to **learning tools**
- **Clever** can also be found at **Office.com**
 - Click the **App Launcher** in the top left.
 - Click on **All Apps** at the bottom
 - **Search for Clever** and click the **App**



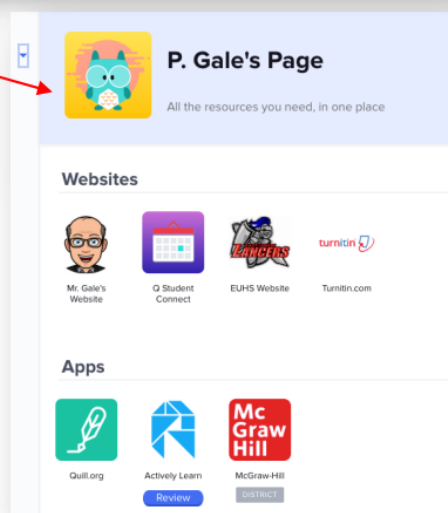
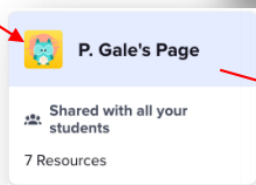
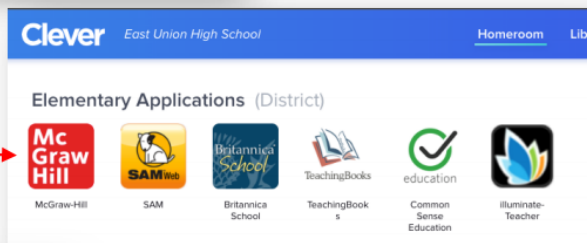
2. Or, you can go direct to Clever.com (If you go through Office.com, skip to step 3)

- Click the blue **“login as student”** button at the top.
- The first time, you will need to **search for your school name**
- You should see **“Manteca Unified School District.”** **Click login with Office 365**
- Clever knows your student’s username and password. It is what helps us login to learning!



3. Choose the Learning Application You Need!

- For example, the red **McGraw Hill** button is used for many English and Math digital books
- If you do not see what you need, you might try clicking on the **teacher’s page**.
- Teachers can add resources here that may be unique to that class.
- Some of these links may require that the student login separately.



Clever is, well, really clever!

- It uses **secure, private, and safe login** for learning apps thanks to Microsoft’s powerful security tools
- It gives teachers a way to organize commonly used learning links and apps all in one place.

Once you are in Clever, look for the Edmentum logo (a black “e” with a rainbow). Once you click on that, your child’s Exact Path program should open on its home page, and he/she can get started on a learning path.
