What is the act?

In 2019, the Alabama Legislature passed the Alabama Literacy Act, which became effective September 1, 2019.









Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, third-grade students are expected to demonstrate sufficient reading skills on the state standardized test for promotion to fourth grade.

What does the law say...









Why was the act established?

• It was established to implement steps to improve the reading proficiency of public school kindergarten to third-grade students to ensure that they can read at or above grade level by the end of the third-grade year.









Ways We are helping our students.

- K-3 teachers are trained with Orton-Gillingham training.
- Certified tutoring during the school day.
- Certified tutors after school for grades 2-3.
- Summer Reading Program
