a. FACES Approval

- i. To meet Student Safety (Goal 2), we would like to spend \$57,600.00 of Title I funding to pay a full-time person from FACES to increase chronically absent student attendance by calling home, and support mental health needs, part of COST process.
- ii. This was added last year, but no data yet on effectiveness. Want to keep it going this year, collect data, and evaluate for relative intervention strategy success.
- iii. Motion to approve: Everlyn Curial second: Julieta Salcedo. Pass: **YES**.

b. Need parent input: Willingness to be on a WASC focus group?

- i. Promoted in ELAC meeting. Council recommends to market through coaches and Booster clubs. Ask parents to come to designated Wednesday meetings.
- ii. Also, suggest use voice calls system to invite as well as website and social media. Instagram. Facebook. Remind system. Multi-generational. Grandparents, etc?

c. School Vision and “World’s Greatest” discussion – update on the wall.

- i. Student Survey – on the wall and mental health.
- ii. Council advises to be less formal in questions asked. Use both positive and negative branching for the wall choice.

- b. **Principal Update – Eric Simoni**
 - i. Glad to be back. Items that we are lacking procedures for. Effort to enforce rules in place. May switch to hard copies for off campus passes. Less kids going off campus means more lunch conflict. This is happening elsewhere in district.
 - ii. Trash cleanup has improved. Students encouraged to take pride in our space. Brief discussion of bathroom supply needs.
