What is the Purpose of the Scholarship?

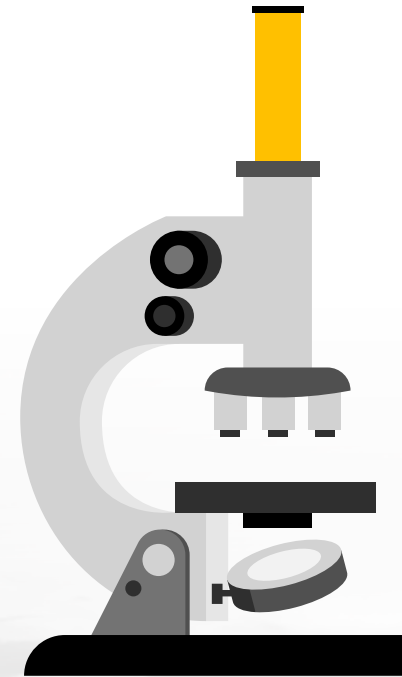
This scholarship helps and encourages individuals who are preparing for careers in technical fields that could lead to employment with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).





Who is Eligible?

- A current or former employee of any office located at the Translab.
- A dependent of a current or former employee defined above.
- A current or former volunteer or student assistant at the Translab.
- A high school senior planning to enroll in college or university in the 2023 academic year with a major in one the fields listed below.
- College applicants must be currently enrolled in a minimum of six units in college or university with an academic major in one of the following:
 - ❖ Engineering,
 - ❖ Materials Science
 - ❖ Engineering Technology
 - ❖ Chemistry
 - ❖ Geology or other Earth Science





Who is Eligible? (continued)

- Applicants, except for dependents, must have completed at least six months of cumulative work time at Translab through temporary or permanent assignment.
- A scholarship recipient will not be eligible to receive the scholarship again, in the year immediately following his or her selection.
- However, previous recipients can reapply for the scholarship in years after the ineligible year.
- Previous applicants will not be reconsidered unless a new application is received.





What is the Amount of the Scholarship?

The number and size of scholarships awarded each year are based on the scholarship applications received, the amount of principal in the fund, and the generosity of contributors. This year the Hveem Scholarship Committee is proud to announce a scholarship fund ***of \$8,000 in total.*** This scholarship can be divided up accordingly depending on the candidate pool received this year.

Background Information

The Francis N. Hveem Memorial Scholarship is named for the late Mr. Francis N. Hveem, the former State Materials Engineer and Chief of the Materials and Research Laboratory. The Transportation Laboratory often referred to as the TransLab, has been reorganized several times since Mr. Hveem retired and is now composed of the Materials Engineering and Testing Services (METS). Mr. Hveem was a civil engineer specializing in materials. His contributions to highway engineering have been known worldwide and helped guide the TransLab to international renown. The scholarship fund was initially established by a generous bequest from the Hveem family and contributions by TransLab employees. The fund is regularly augmented through donations and fundraisers to ensure that scholarships may continue to be awarded.
