Dear 2020 Hughes Scholarship Applicant:

Harold Hughes, former Superintendent of Manteca Unified School District, has established a scholarship to assist current employees and/or their graduating dependent children as they pursue their careers in college. Two scholarships, in the amount of \$250 each will be awarded to the most qualified recipients. One will be awarded to a current employee of Manteca Unified School District and one to a graduating senior of a current employee.

The following criteria will be applied:

- 1) Must be a current employee or the graduating dependent child of a current Manteca Unified School District employee to apply for this scholarship.
- 2) Must be accepted to a two- or four-year accredited college.
- 3) Money will be paid directly to the employee upon verification of enrollment in a minimum of three (3) units in college.
- 4) Money will be paid directly to the graduating senior upon verification of full-time enrollment (12 or more units) in college.
