



D Remediation Options

If you earned a “D” in an “a-g” class,
you must remediate or validate that class to be eligible for college.
Here are your options!

World History

- a. SAT Subject score of 540 meets one year requirement
- b. Score of 3, 4, or 5 on AP European History or AP World History test meets one year requirement
- c. Earn a “C” or better in a UC-transferrable course in World History, World Cultures and/or World Geography at a Community College (3 or more semester units)
- d. Repeat class; semester that “D” grade was earned (depends on space, see counselor for availability)

US History

- a. SAT Subject score of 550 meets one year requirement
- b. Score of 3, 4, or 5 on AP US History test meets one-year requirement
- c. Earn a “C” or better in a UC-transferrable course at a Community College (3 or more semester units)
- d. “C” or better in Government will meet the “A” area requirement for 1 semester
- e. Repeat class; semester that “D” grade was earned (depends on space, see counselor for availability)

English

- a. SAT Writing and Language Test Score of 31 meets first 3 years
- b. SAT Writing and Language Test Score of 36 meets entire 4-year requirement
- c. ACT combined English/Writing or English Language Arts score of 24 meets the first 3 years
- d. ACT combined English/Writing or English Language Arts score of 30 meets the entire 4-year requirement
- e. SAT Subject Test in Literature score of 560 meets the first 3 years
- f. Score of 3, 4, or 5 on AP English Language or AP English Literature meets all 4 years of the requirement
- g. Earn a “C” or better in a UC-transferrable English composition and literature course at a Community College meets the fourth year and/or the entire requirement (3 or more semester units)
- h. Repeat class; semester that “D” grade was earned (depends on space, see counselor for availability)
