
> This is the SVSD District home page. Click on the STAFF RESOURCES tab.




Click on the Absence Management (Formerly Aesop) icon from the Staff Resources menu.



Once on the Absence Management login page, you may enter your ID Number and Pin (which you have been previously emailed upon your hire with the SVSD).



This is your Absence Management (formerly Aesop) homepage. This is where you will enter all of your absences. If you are sick and cannot come to work, you MUST enter your absence in right away, so that a substitute can be contacted and your time off covered. You can enter your sick day into Skyward later, but Absence Management must be updated ASAP.




1) To create an absence, select the date or dates you will be absent.





- 6) When entering the sub hours, you MUST FIRST CLICK ON THE CHAIN-LINK ICON. You need to enter the Substitute hours if they are NOT THE SAME AS YOUR REGULAR HOURS. Once again, remember to select custom report hours for your sub if your absence is on a Friday.
- 7) You have the option to enter notes to be viewed by either your Sub or your Administrator or both if you prefer.

8) You may upload attachments such as lesson plans for your sub to access.



- 9) Once you have entered all of the information, click the "CREATE ABSENCE" tab to continue.*


 *If, PRIOR to entering your absence, you have already pre-arranged a sub, you are able to assign your vacancy to that sub specifically. Aesop will not perform this task for you. You absolutely must speak and confirm with your sub before you assign it to them.
- 10) You are able to search for a Sub by name if you'd like, or you can select from your preferred list.
- 11) Once you have located the Sub you wish to assign your absence to, and they have agreed to work for you, click "Assign".
- 12) You will receive a Confirmation Number when your absence has been created.
- 13) If you created an absence but did not assign a pre-arranged sub, Absence Management's automated call-out system will call all available and appropriately skilled subs to try to fill your absence(s), as will the SVSD substitute coordinator.
- 14) When you have an absence successfully scheduled, your home page will look like this, with your future absence(s) under the "Scheduled" tab, and any previous absences under the "Past" tab.
