

**Memorandum of Agreement
By and Between
Snoqualmie Valley School District (SVSD)
And
Snoqualmie Coaches and Activities Association (SCAA)
Regarding Game Manager**

The Snoqualmie Coaches and Activities Association (SCAA) and the Snoqualmie Valley School District (SVSD) enter into the following agreement related to Game Managers for certain sporting events.

During the 2022-2023 school year the District will pilot a Game Manager program at the high school level in lieu of the Event Supervisor stipend.

Game Managers will be hired for the high school sports listed below.

- Basketball, Boys
- Basketball, Girls
- Soccer, Boys
- Soccer, Girls
- Volleyball
- Wrestling

The Game Manager will be responsible for game management activities which included, but are not limited to: checking out and returning ticket sales items and cash before and after the event, ensuring Game Officials have access to a locker room/changing area, setting up required equipment (i.e.: score clock, shot clock, etc.), and will troubleshoot event issues related to supplies and facility.

The Game Manager positions will be advertised at Mount Si High School for interested staff, with the intent of having one game manager per sport.

Game Managers will be paid \$23 per hour, with most events being 5 hours in length. Basketball Quad nights may be split between two people or may be one person working more than 5 hours.

This pilot program will be reviewed prior to the start of the 2023-2024 school year.

This agreement sunsets at the end of the 2022-2023 school year or until another agreement supersedes this one, whichever comes first.
