Alvin Community College - STRIVE



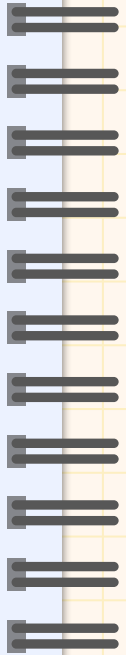
Alvin Community College [STRIVE](#) program has a summer class open to HS students. It is listed under Other STRIVE Courses.

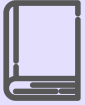
