These individuals are going to or from their job sites or work-related activities.

- **Work hours: Monday–Friday, 7am–5pm**
- **\$18.54 hourly wage, no-cost OSPI Certified Class CDL-B training contingent on 8 week commitment**
- **Starting pay with CDL-B endorsement is \$24.04 as a PSESD substitute school bus driver**

*Class B CDL with School Bus & Passenger endorsements; training available at no cost to volunteers who complete a minimum number of volunteer hours. Please contact us for further details.

MINIMUM DRIVER QUALIFICATIONS:

- **21 years of age or older**
- **Pass a federal background check with fingerprinting**
- **Submit to drug and alcohol screenings**
- **Possess an acceptable driving record for at least 5 years**
