## CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AND REVIEW

An aligned, comprehensive program of curriculum, instruction, and assessment that serves the needs of students within a competency-based system must include a process for ongoing, data-driven curriculum development and review as well as an ongoing cycle for selection and adoption of district textbooks and other instructional materials aligned with the curriculum review process.

- District curriculum development and review projects will be prioritized annually according to identified needs based upon:
- District exit competencies, benchmarks, and assessments
- Strategic Plan Review
- State standards and assessments
- Common site-based concerns regarding student achievement
- Ongoing cycle of revision and update

Priority district curriculum development and review projects shall include the participation of all stakeholders when applicable:

- Teacher representatives from each grade level or department that will be affected by the curriculum project (Teachers should comprise the majority of membership.)
- Parents and/or community representatives including representatives from higher education and/or business and industry
- Support staff representatives
- Students
- Administrators of affected grade levels

District resources for the selection and adoption of instructional materials will be prioritized and allocated according to identified needs based upon:

- District exit competencies, benchmarks, and assessments
- State adoption cycle
- Common site-based resource needs
- Ongoing cycle of revision and update
