PROGRAM

INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES

The Board shall supply each teaching staff member with the supplies, materials, and equipment necessary, within budgetary constraints, for the implementation of the approved program and each student with the supplies and materials required for the successful completion of courses of study.

Exceptions to this policy shall occur in the following circumstances:

- 1. Where individualized and non-reusable clothing or equipment is required for reasons of safety, health, or the protection of school property, students will be required to provide their own clothing or equipment that shall meet standards set by the school. Such standards shall be those reasonably related to the consideration of safety, health, and protection of property.
- 2. Where students prepare and/or create items in fine arts or career and technical education courses that they are permitted to keep, they shall pay the District the cost of the materials used in accordance with administrative regulations.
- 3. Students who volunteer for participation in co-curricular activities may be required to purchase supplies necessary for the conduct of the activity.

Where requirements to pay for clothing or supplies impose a financial hardship on a student, the Board may assume the cost. The Superintendent shall devise procedures designed to assure that no student need be denied participation in the school program for financial reasons; such procedures shall at the same time guard the privacy of each student.
