PROGRAMS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Douglas County School District shall ensure a reasonably equal educational opportunity to pupils with disabilities ages 3-22 years of age. It shall be the policy of the Board that pupils with disabilities attending the schools of this District shall be offered a program of instruction in a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) that is specially designed to meet the students' individual needs in the students' least restrictive environment (LRE).

Douglas County School District Administration and Teachers are required to adhere to requirements within the Douglas County School District Special Education Procedures Manual and Resource Book.
