PROGRAM

COMPENSATORY EDUCATION

The Board recognizes that the discharge of its responsibility to provide an educational program for each student in the District may require special help for some students beyond the regular classroom program. The Board shall be responsible for such remedial and compensatory programs.

When the student's learning problem is sufficient to warrant help beyond the capacity of the classroom teacher, special remedial instruction and services may be utilized within the existing capacity of the District.

The Board also recognizes that parental input regarding the design and implementation of projects serves to aid in effectively providing compensatory services to District students. In compliance with federal requirements, the District will detail in the annual Federal ECIA Chapter I Program the manner in which parent participation was employed in the development of the application. Additionally, the application will, when appropriate, specify the manner in which parents participated in funded project activities.
