PROGRAM ASSESSMENT

Thorough program assessment ensures the best use of District resources in terms of personnel, time, and support materials. Support programs should contribute to the goals of the District with an emphasis on programs that promote student competency.

Existing District-wide support programs are to be reviewed for effectiveness at each renewal juncture. Newly adopted support programs are to be evaluated for possible implementation, through use of a systematic method of assessment determined by the Superintendent.

Sites are encouraged to use the same process before implementing new support programs at their sites and may be required to do so at the Superintendent's request. This is particularly important if the support program impacts instructional time or has implications beyond the individual school studying the proposed or existing programs.

Recommendations for program improvement and/or implementation will provide direction for District administrators, site administrators, program specialists, and other individuals responsible for the programs used throughout the District.
