PROGRAM

CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Board of Trustees shall provide a program of career and technical education to prepare students for gainful employment as semiskilled workers, technicians or semiprofessionals in recognized occupations and in new or emerging occupations. The career and technical educational program should assist students in the making of informed and meaningful career and college decisions.

The Board will support a program of career and technical education, which may include career and technical courses of study as part of the regular curriculum of the school and a cooperative education program to offer students experience in employment opportunities or internships, provided such a program is integrated with the student's regular school program.

A pupil who successfully completes a program of career and technical education and who otherwise satisfies the requirements for graduation from high school must be awarded a high school diploma with an endorsement indicating that the pupil has successfully completed the program of career and technical education. The provisions of this subsection do not preclude a pupil from receiving more than one endorsement on his or her diploma, if applicable.
