HEALTH EXAMINATIONS

The Board shall require that students of this District submit to health examinations as required by law to protect the school community from the spread of communicable disease; to ensure that the student's participation in health, safety, and physical education courses meets his individual needs and to ensure that the learning potential of each child is not lessened by a remediable physical disability.

Any student shall be exempt from the examination if his parents or guardian file with the school, a written statement objecting to the examination.

In addition to those examinations required by law, each candidate for a place on a school interscholastic athletic squad or team shall be given a health examination by a physician in accordance with rules of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association.
