

ELIGIBILITY OF OUT-OF-STATE, NON-RESIDENT CHILDREN, (GUARDIANSHIP)

The Board shall operate the schools of this District for the benefit of children resident in the District and eligible for attendance in the schools of this District and such others as may be admitted pursuant to statute and the policy of the Board.

A child who resides in the District with an adult other than the child's parent shall not be eligible for enrollment unless the adult resident with whom he resides has been appointed as guardian of the child and *proof of guardianship is submitted to the school principal. Guardian's proof of residing within the District must be provided.

Schools must immediately enroll children and youth in homeless situations (Students in Transition (SIT) and Unaccompanied Youth), even when records normally required for enrollment are not available. See Board Policy 542 and Administrative Regulation 542 for procedures for enrolling and providing appropriate services to Students in Transition.

Regularly enrolled children whose parents have moved out of the School District may be permitted to finish the semester without payment of tuition, provided the parents move from the District during that semester. Exceptions may be granted for seniors with the approval of the Superintendent.

The only approved method for an out-of-state, non-resident student to attend Douglas County schools is through an approved tuition agreement entered into between this District and the out-of-state school district in which the student(s) reside(s). Any tuition agreement entered into must meet the requirements of NRS 392.010. Other than through a formalized agreement with an out-of-state district, students must meet Nevada residency requirements (including guardianship). Individual tuition agreements between parents and the District are not permitted.
