PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS

The Board recognizes the value to students of sharing their talents and skills with the community through participation and performances in public events.

The Board endorses such performances when they constitute a learning experience that contributes to the educational program, they do not interfere with other scheduled activities of the school, and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety and well-being of the students who will be involved.

Requests for public performances that involve students in overnight trips shall require the approval of the Board; all other requests for public performances shall require the approval of the principal.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations to implement this policy that require that parental permission is sought and received before students may participate; no student is compelled to participate in a public performance or penalized in any way for failure to do so; no student, group of students, or employee of this Board receives compensation for the performance in public of students organized for a school activity; and the interests of students is protected and guarded against exploitation.
