STUDENTS

CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY

The Board believes that the schools should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions. The Board charges each student in the schools of this District with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his use. Students who cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures.

The parents and guardians of students shall be responsible for all books and any and all other material or equipment loaned to the children in their charge, and shall pay to the clerk of the Board of Trustees, or to any other person authorized by the Board to receive the same, the full purchase price of all such books, materials, or equipment destroyed, lost, or so damaged as to make them unfit for use by other students succeeding to their classes.

The Superintendent shall establish reasonable rules and regulations governing the care and custody of such school property, and for the payment of appropriate restitution for damage thereto.
